Diver Medic Technician Course

Students enrolled in this 48-hour NBDHMT- approved Diving Medical Technician course engage in didactic and practical training on the recognition, stabilization and treatment of decompression and other diving-related injuries.

Drill using an on-site 72" multi-place chamber and gain an understanding of a vessel based Transportable Re-compression Chamber System (TRCS). Upon successful completion of the course, students can apply to NBDHMT for certification as a Diver Medic.



Specific course topics include:

- Diving physiology
- Recognition of marine life hazards
- Clinical assessment of diving injuries such as barotrauma and decompression sickness
- Neurological examinations
- Hyperbaric chamber operations

Course Fee: \$1,300 (\$800 if you are taking it for recertification)

Course Dates: March 18 - 23, 2024
(NBDHMT board certification exam will take place on March 23, 2024)

Prerequisites: Current EMT certification (certified military, commercial or recreational diver certification preferred)
