



Dr. Alfonso has degrees in Civil Engineer and Master of Science in Hydraulics from the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM), as well as a PhD in Geophysics and Environment from the Polytechnic Institute of Grenoble (INPG), France. Dr. Gutiérrez is Coordinator of the Water Research Center (CIAQ) of the Autonomous University of Querétaro (UAQ) where he is a full-time Professor and Researcher. He is responsible for the Academic Body of Hydraulics and Coordinator of the Master of Science on Environmental Hydrology Program of the UAQ Faculty of Engineering of. Also, he is the Coordinator for the Latin American and Caribbean International Flood Initiative, IFI-LAC, member of the International Group of Experts in water-related disasters, and Editor-in-Chief of the Aqua-LAC Journal of the UNESCO Intergovernmental Hydrological Programme (IHP). Dr. Gutiérrez is a member of the National System of Researchers-Mexico since 2005, he has more than 90 scientific publications and 16 registered technological developments.
